The CYO of Mercer County operates a Summer REC (Recreation/Education Camp) Program at the CYO Center in Trenton. This camp is for children ages 5 (have already attended Kindergarten) to 12 years old enrolled in our designated, State Subsidized slots (parents pay on a sliding fee scale based on family size and income); a limited number of Child Care Connection voucher or non-subsidized slots may also be available.

Children attending the CYO Summer Recreation Education Camp will have an opportunity to participate in a variety of activities. All campers swim a few times each week.

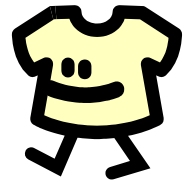
Consistent attendance is mandatory! Children must attend at least 80% per state regulations.
